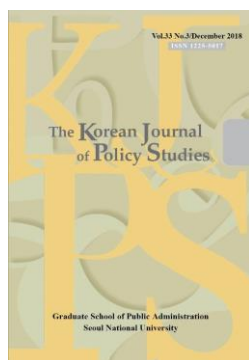

LEADING AND MANAGING

Topic of the conference

As the COVID-19 pandemic continues, we see governments adopting a number of different approaches to manage during this turbulent time. This pandemic driven innovation requires governments to address fundamental challenges to government capacity on issues related to sustainability and social equity. These high stakes policies will have an important influence not only on the way different nations combat the pandemic, but also as they rebuild in the post-COVID-19 world. This year's conference builds upon last year's theme, which focused on the importance of leadership and management capacity in this crisis, by focusing on how governments are leveraging different policy and administrative tools during this unprecedented period. The 2021 IPMN Conference seeks to advance such discussions. In particular, this year, we bring the theme of sustainability, innovation and social equity in order to discuss the 'post-pandemic' society and the role of government.

To this end, we welcome proposal submissions that address the following topics:

1. Crisis management
2. Post-pandemic society and the role and legitimacy of government
3. Sustainability and Social Equity
 - a. Global commitments on climate change
 - b. Official Development Assistance
4. Innovation
 - a. Government, markets, and competitiveness
 - b. Energy policy

LEADING AND MANAGING

In the same vein, we can also develop a set of similar questions and arguments about public management.

FORMAL REQUIREMENTS

Paper format, key dates and publication opportunities

Participants who wish to present their research at the IPMN 2021 conference are welcome to send an extended abstract in WORD FORMAT (.doc or .docx) according to the following guidelines. Registration is obligatory for all participants by the **23rd of July 2021**.

Each abstract should include

- Title of the proposed article
- Authors' information,
- Abstract text of 500 words
- Max. 5 keywords
- Paper type (Academic/Practical)
- Bibliographical references

A first draft of the abstract is due by **2nd of July 2021**, and must be submitted to snu.gspa.conference@gmail.com

By **16th of July 2021**, authors will be given notice of the acceptance of the submitted abstracts, reviewed by a scientific committee member.

By **13th of Aug 2021**, accepted full papers will be submitted by the authors, based on the suggestions from the referees.

Each full paper should include

Character	Times-News-Roman, 12
Key-words	Max. 5 items
Max.paper length	7000 words
Footnotes	Footnotes at the bottom of each page (please limit the use of footnotes)
Citations	References in the text should be cited by putting in brackets the name(s) of the author(s) and the year of the reference [e.g.: (Porter 1982)]
Bibliography	At the end of the paper, according to the following standard: Osborne S. (2016). Public management research over the decades: What are we writing about?, <i>Public Management Review</i> , 19, 2, p. 109-113.

All received extended abstracts will undergo a double blind peer review. To facilitate the double blind review process, abstracts must consist of two pages: in the first one, author(s) name(s), affiliations, email address(es) and paper title are listed; the second one includes the abstract text, together with the repetition of the paper title. At the end of the abstract, please include short biographical notes of each author.

The best papers presented at the conference could possibly be eligible for publication in one of these journals:

- **Korea Journal of Policy Studies** (KJPS, <http://kjps.snu.ac.kr>),
- **International Public Management Journal** (IPMJ, <https://www.tandfonline.com/loi/upmj20>)
- **International Public Management Review** (IPMR, <http://ipmr.net>)

In addition, the editorial committee of the journal *Management International* (MI) considers the possibility of devoting a special report to the theme of the conference. A decision will be made and communicated to the organizers as soon as possible. If it is favorable, the best papers presented at the Conference could be submitted to MI's peer review process, in consultation with the authors.
